The East Devon Pebblebed Heaths Conservation Trust was established by Clinton Devon Estates in 2006. Based out of our office near East Budleigh (East Devon), our charitable objective is to conserve the natural environment of the Pebblebed Heaths (1,159 ha) and the Otter Estuary (90 ha) for the benefit of the public.

The Pebblebed Heaths were declared a National Nature Reserve in 2020, with the Otter Estuary being added to the NNR in 2024 following the completion of the Lower Otter Restoration Project. Together, these two nature reserves provide vital space for supporting the health and wellbeing of local communities, with >1million visit annually. A new masterplan for the Pebblebed Heaths NNR is to be published in 2024. The 'Pebblebeds for All' project has been designed to focus on delivering objectives from the new master plan which fall into the 'People and Nature' theme, ensuring that the NNR delivers for local communities.
